Ashton is a residential care home providing 24 hour personal care for five young people with learning and physical disabilities and who have very high needs.

The house opened in 2004 after major extension and renovation work and has been subtly adapted to meet the needs of people with disabilities. Ashton is in an established residential area near to the centre of Sale, Cheshire.

The house has a large family sized kitchen and dining room, great for people wanting to get involved with meal preparation or meet with family and friends. People like to chill out in the lounges where they can watch TV, listen to music, or catch up with each other.

There is a real buzz about the house. It is full of life with people coming and going throughout the day. Week days are filled with going to college and learning new skills. Everyone helps with the daily tasks such as going to the supermarket for the weekly shop, cleaning and tidying. Some might say this is an unfortunate part of family life, others call it retail therapy.

Free time is spent doing lots of things such as going to church, to youth and social clubs and trips to the theatre. Ashton is a party house and everyone loves to celebrate — birthdays, anniversaries, Easter, Christmas, Halloween....there's nothing better than dressing up and having loads of fun.

The residents of Ashton like to support other local groups and businesses and get involved with a strong community spirit. People love to have a coffee in Ashton Village. The residents of Ashton also have great relationship with the local Salvation Army group, often attending their services on Sundays, inviting them round for coffee mornings and they even perform brass band concerts for us!
