## **How do we spend your money?**

We've raised significantly more in this financial year than in previous ones. That's because we have been fundraising to convert and renovate a property to become our 5th residential service. At an estimated cost of £1.1m to do this, we have been lucky to rely on donations and pledges from a number of charitable trusts and foundations. We have some way to go with our fundraising but we're pleased to say that work on the house will start in spring 2020.



Stockies Juniors, our kid's club, has gone from strength to strength since it started in 2017. We have increased the age to 16 years so we can reach more children and their families. And there are plans to open a new club in the future so we can help even more kids to have the same play experiences as other children. We're pleased to have received multi-year funding to support this much needed project.

We have also used your donations to help fund our social clubs, Dream Days project, Christmas parties and Summer Ball for our service users, holidays, materials for our Lifeskills sessions, transport, expensive specialist disability equipment and keeping our spaces looking tip top.
